About the project

Youth Exchange Colors of European Culture Heritage a day project bringing together youth from four countries: Poland, Turkey, Croatia, Germany and the Czech Republic. The main goal of the project will be to prepare and conduct a youth exchange with the active participation of participants at all stages of the project and with the involvement of the local community in as many activities as possible.

The main goals are:

- raising the awareness of young people, including exchange participants and the local community, about European values, their significance and perception in different cultures**
- active participation and involvement of young people in activities related to the local community, with particular emphasis on people at risk of social exclusion and reduced opportunities due to economic, geographic and social barriers**
- educating and increasing competences related to personal development through active participation of young people in project activities**
- the possibility of personal expression of each participant, due to the opportunities offered by the participation in the presented initiative.**

Participants

Our project consists of two activities - a preparatory visit and youth exchange. We are young people between the ages of 18 and 30.

APV

10 people will take part in the preparatory meeting (one leader and one person who will be a participant with fewer opportunities and at the same time will be fluent in a chosen field such as dance, video)

Youth Exchange

35 people from 5 partner countries will take part in the exchange. These will be people who will be motivated to carry out their performance on European values and cultural heritage. Some of these people will belong to the group of people with fewer opportunities. In addition, there will be people who are experienced in various arts like theater, doing video, music and dance, who will implement the idea of learning from each other.

APV

A properly planned preparatory visit will help us introduce any small modifications to the schedule before the exchange and will allow to see the place of exchange and the possibilities it offers for the whole exchange. We also don't forget about how important it will be to make everyone aware of the impact this project can have on them, but also on the local community.

We are also aware of the dissemination of results - which you also want to be aware of during meetings and accordingly discuss. Also, due to participating in the exchange of people with fewer opportunities, we want to provide them safety and psychological comfort, therefore they will take part in the preparatory visit.

It will be very important for us to create an open dialogue and open to everyone's needs participants.

The meeting will take place at the "HUCUŁ" Summer Camp and Holiday Center. At the same time there will take place a Youth City Councils seminar. Outside there is a large dining room, a lounge and a place for outside activities. Free wireless internet access is available.

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

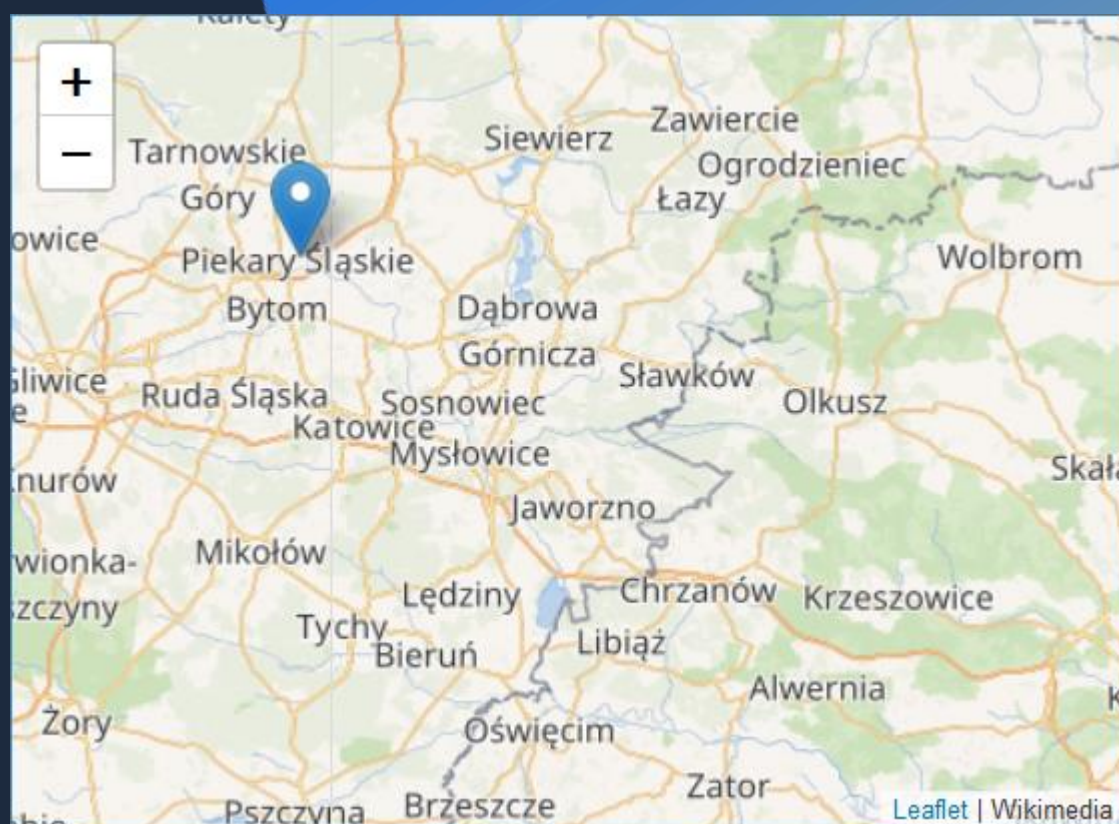
Piekary Śląskie are located very close to Katowice airport- around 20 km

GENERAL INFORMATION

Weather conditions:

The average temperature in October is between 16 - 20 degrees of Celcius during the day. However, as the climate changes it might happen the temperatures will be a bit higher. Internet

In hotel is also a very limited wireless internet in the public area, the speed might be very slow in comparison to your normal internet in your country. Please be prepared that you won't get a proper internet access for the whole program.

Dress code:

Please bring some semi elegant dress for some meeting. Also don't forget casual comfortable sport wear, slippers, or sneakers for indoor, jacket and comfortable shoes for outdoor activities. **DONT FORGET TO TAKE YOUR OWN TOWELS.**

INSURANCE

Remember health insurance is your responsibility so make sure you have medical insurance. Health insurance will NOT be provided or reimbursed by the mobility organizers. However, it is a mandatory requirement for all participants to provide your own health insurance. Also you are required to have travel insurance. Please note that each participant is required to have travel insurance and health insurance and it is not reimbursable as it is your choice with which company and plan suits you

MEDICATION

If you take any medication please remember to bring it with you, we have pharmacies here but if you need prescription medication you cannot buy them over the counter without a prescription. Also please inform us of any medical conditions we need to be aware of in the registration application. If participants have any allergies especially to food this needs to be expressed in the application form above, because changes to the menu will not be possible once the project starts. We suggest you to bring your own cosmetic articles and self-care products. No need to bring sheets which will be provided by the hostel. Just in case take your own towels.

DIET

If you have any special conditions (diet, you are vegan, vegetarian, allergies) let us know about these conditions in advance.

We covered your travel expenses into a certain amount. Please, make sure to keep your boarding passes, tickets and receipts, including for the return.
